Groups can set up a display, static or interactive and fairgoers will vote their favorite. **The winner will receive \$500.**

Things to Know:

- Set up can begin as early as Tuesday, June 12 at 8 a.m.
- Tear down must be completed by Tuesday, June 19 at 5 p.m.
- Booths can be static or interactive/staffed. For example: dancers can be part of the display, you can plant seedlings, a coloring/crafting area for kids can be set up
- Food and beverage giveaways are prohibited, other handouts are acceptable and encouraged
- Each fairgoer who enters the building will be given the opportunity to vote. Email addresses and/or phone numbers and different colored ballots daily will ensure each person only votes once per day
- The buildings are open daily until 9 p.m.
- Each group will receive 4 wristbands (good daily for parking and entry) for restocking purposes
